FEATURES AND BENEFITS

APPLICATIONS

Freeing fasteners, nuts, bolts, studs, pins, valves, pipe couplings, machine parts, etc. • Effective for all rusted and corroded parts

DIRECTIONS

1. For best results, use when can is between 40°F and 90°F (21°C and 32°C). Protect surrounding areas from spray mist.
2. Shake can briefly before use.
3. Spray surface with steady even strokes at a distance of 6 to 8 inches (15 to 20cm). For pinpoint application, use extension tube.



4. If clogging develops, turn sprayhead 1/4 turn or remove and clean sprayhead slot. DO NOT stick pin or other objects into can opening. With can and sprayhead pointed away from you, reinsert sprayhead with a gentle twisting motion.
5. Completely empty cans may be recycled or disposed of with regular trash. Dispose partially empty cans responsibly. DO NOT incinerate or compact.

IF ON SKIN: Wash thoroughly with water. Remove all contaminated clothing. **Storage:** Store locked up. Protect from sunlight and do not expose to temperatures exceeding 50°C/122°F. **Disposal:** Dispose of product in accordance with local/regional/national/international regulations. **Additional Precaution Statements:** Vapors may ignite explosively and cause a flash fire. Prevent buildup of vapors by opening windows and doors to achieve cross ventilation.
